Hall of Fame Award Selection Criteria

Revised October 2024

This document identifies selection criteria for the Hall of Fame.

The Hall of Fame, BIFHSGO's longest running award, honours members for their contributions to the Society, family history research and genealogy. One Hall of Fame nominee (individual or team) will be inducted per year and the nominee will have recently contributed to the goals of BIFHSGO. Winners [PDF] have reflected a wide range of contributions.

Nominations to the Hall of Fame are accepted annually, and the nominee is inducted at BIFHSGO's Annual General Meeting in June. Current members of the Board are not eligible for nomination.

Criteria include:

- The advancement of BIFHSGO objectives (vision, mission and values)
- The advancement of BIFHSGO projects or activities; e.g., publishing, educational programs
- Outstanding service to the Society over a period of time
- The advancement of genealogy and family history in general

Each January, members are invited to nominate a candidate for consideration by the Board. The nomination period ends 30 April. For more information, please contact secretary@bifhsgo.ca
