Hall of Fame Award Selection Criteria

The Hall of Fame, BIFHSGO's longest running award, honours one or more members for their meritorious service to the Society, family history research and genealogy. Nominees should meet the criteria set out below and have made a significant contribution to the goals of BIFHSGO. Past winners have reflected a wide range of contributions.

Early each year, members are invited to nominate a candidate for consideration by the Board with the nomination period ending on 30 April. The nominee(s) is/are inducted into the Hall of Fame at BIFHSGO's Annual General Meeting in June.

Current members of the Board are not eligible for nomination. The award may be made posthumously.

Criteria include:

- The advancement of BIFHSGO's objectives
- The advancement of BIFHSGO projects or activities, e.g. publishing, educational programs
- Outstanding service to the Society over a period of time
- The advancement of genealogy and family history in general.
