

# FAMILY HISTORY WRITING COMPETITION

# Celebrate BIFHSGO's 30th Anniversary in 2024! Write a story from your British Isles family history and Win a Prize!

### What you need to know:

- You must be a BIFHSGO member on 31 May 2024.
- You may only enter one family story, which hasn't been published elsewhere.
- If you are writing about your family after they left the British Isles, you must clearly show your family's origins in the British Isles.
- You may write a story about the origins of your British Isles family, the process of discovering a person/family, or an interesting fact/event in your family history; the story must be true and the facts not fictionalized in your account.
- You must submit your entry digitally as a PDF file.
- Your story must be written in English.
- The maximum length of the entry is 4,000 words, including bibliographies and endnotes.
- Illustrations (photos, drawings, charts, maps) are encouraged.
- A family tree chart for the family/individual in the story must accompany your entry as an aid to the judges but will not be included as part of the entry evaluation. Hand-drawn tree charts are acceptable but must be digitized/scanned and submitted electronically.
- Entries, winning or not, may be published in BIFHSGO's journal *Anglo-Celtic Roots* (following the usual editing process with the ACR editorial team).
- Competition organizers and the judges are excluded from entering.

#### **Entries will be judged on:**

- the appeal and impact of the topic/story
- the quality of the language: facts conveyed in a concise, grammatical and interesting style
- the organization and presentation: easy to follow, with a central focus and logical flow
- the writing "mechanics": proficient grammar, word choice and sentence structure
- the effective use of images to enhance the subject matter

The deadline for submitting your story and the extract of your family tree is midnight on 31 May 2024.

# There are three ways to enter electronically:

- 1. You can submit your story by completing the submission form online and attaching your documents to the upload.
- 2. You can complete form below, scan it and attach it to your email when you submit your entry to <a href="mailto:competition@bifhsgo.ca">competition@bifhsgo.ca</a>.
- 3. You can send an email with the entry information requested on the form in the text of the email and send your documents as attachments.
