CATHOLIC GIRL EMIGRANTS GO TO CANADA.



A party of about forty Catholic girls left Liverpool on Friday, under the charge of Mgr. G. V. Hudson, to find new homes in Canada. The girls are travelling under the auspices of the Catholic Emigration Association, which will look after their welfare until they are thoroughly all settled in the Dominion. An interview with Mgr.

Hudson appears below :

EMIGRANTS ORDAINED

TWO BOYS TO BECOME PRIESTS AND TWO GIRLS NUNS.

(From the "Universe" Correspondent.)

LIVERPOOL, Friday.

A comparatively large percentage of the Catholic boys and girls who emigrate from this country to Canada enter the service of the Church, Mgr. Hudson, secretary of the Catholic Emigration Association, informed me when I interviewed him to-day on the C.P.R. liner "Montclare."

Mgr. Hudson is making his seventeenth trip to Canada, with a party of about thirty children.

"When I arrive this time," he said, "I shall see two of the boys we have taken to Canada ordained priests and two girls professed as nuns. Altogether fourteen of our boys have become priests, and some now have parishes of their own. Fifty of the girls are nuns."

Mgr. Hudson is also looking forward to celebrating the Nuptial Mass at the marriages of four girls who went to the Dominion under the Association's auspices.

More than 7,000 children have been taken to Canada by the Association, and Mgr. Hudson says 98 per cent. have turned out well.



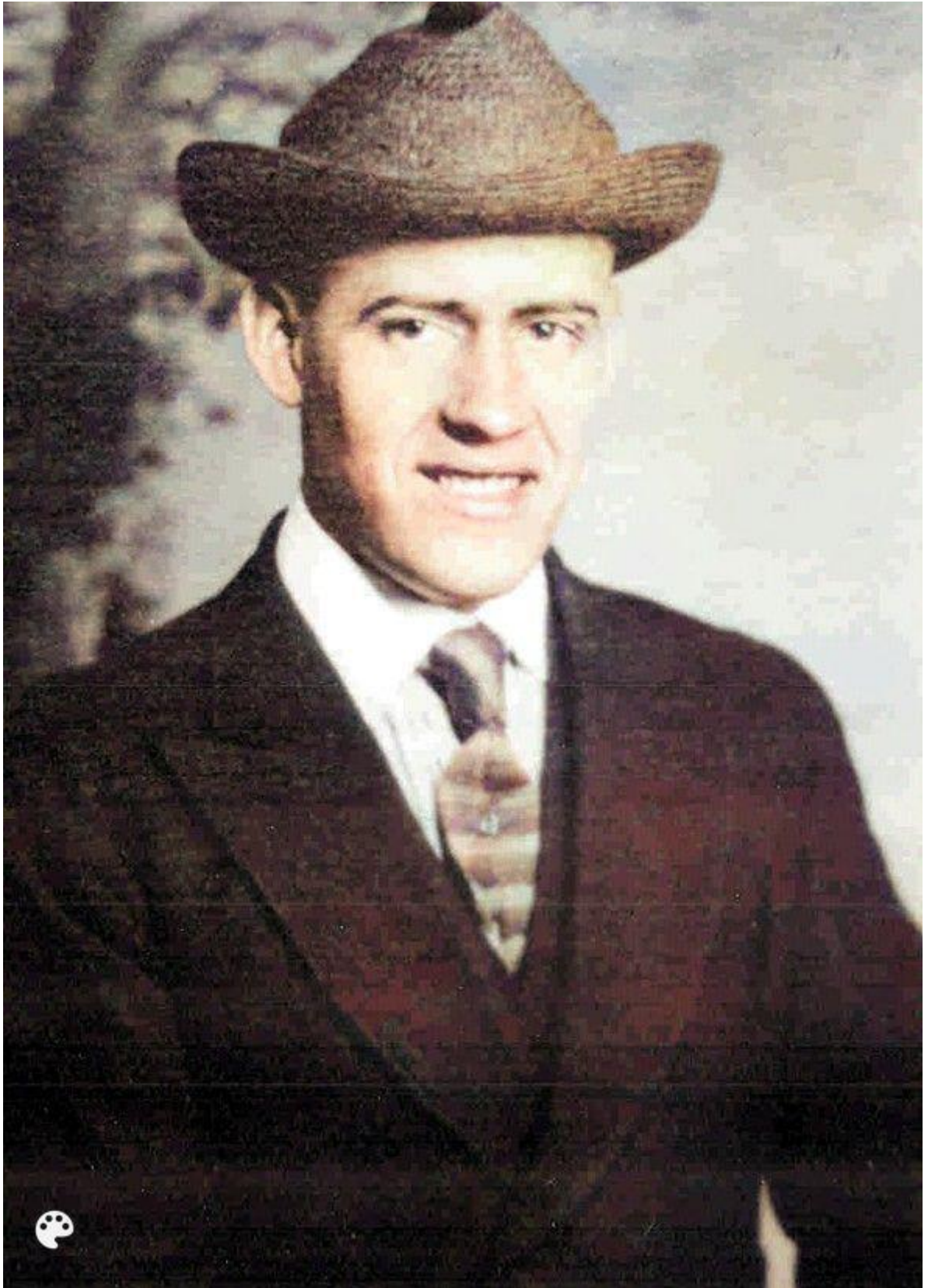
